## Camp Staff

**Mike Warren**  
Head Coach



Mike Warren enters his 26th year as the head baseball coach at Barton. Through 25 seasons, Warren has accumulated an overall record of 755 wins to 500 losses. His teams have won five Jayhawk Conference Western Division championships and two Western Sub-Regional championships. Warren has also surpassed his 800th win standing at 852-610 all-time as a collegiate head coach.

Over the past few summers, Warren has seen three of his former pitchers find their way into Major League Baseball as Nate Field (breaking in with the Kansas City Royals and this past season with the Florida Marlins), David Sanders (Chicago White Sox), and Jason Stanford (Cleveland Indians) have made it big in the Big Leagues. In addition, three Cougars were selected in the first eight rounds of the 2006 MLB Draft: Chad Lee (pitcher, 4th round, Oakland A's), Jeff Christy (catcher, 6th round, Minnesota Twins), and Nate Hedrick (pitcher, 8th round, New York Mets). Former pitchers Ryan Phillips (Red Sox), Derek McDaid (Padres), Chris Reddout (Blue Jays), Steve Edlefsen (Giants), and Ron Morales (White Sox) also pitched in the minor leagues last season.

**Brent Biggs**  
Assistant Coach



Brent Biggs is in his 2nd year with Barton, returning to the school that he started his collegiate career at. Biggs played for the Cougars in 2005 and 2006. He began his coaching career in 2008 in the Northwoods League.

This past summer, Biggs helped the Rochester Honkers of the Northwoods League coaching the hitting and infield where he produced 3 infielders to the NWL All-Star Team.

Biggs was a 1st team all Jayhawk West selection his sophomore year at Barton as a 2nd baseman. That season his hit .300 as well as fielded .958. His freshman season, Biggs was an honorable mention selection to the All West team. Biggs started 105 of 108 games.

**Shane Warren**  
Assistant Coach



Coach Shane Warren begins his second season at Barton County. Before coming to Barton, Warren worked for the Greater Wichita YMCA as a sports coordinator and membership consultant. Prior to that, Warren spent one year as a student assistant at Fort Hays State University where the team posted a 32-16 record.

Coach Brett Becker is in his first season at Barton after finishing up his playing career last season. He played at both Cowley County and then Fort Hays State University. Coach Becker helped lead Cowley County to a Jayhawk East Conference Title. He earned All-Conference and All-Region honors from his infield and DH position at Fort Hays State.
