Oliver Twelvetrees is entering his fourth season as head coach at Barton. He is a native of Swansea, Wales. In his first three seasons he has brought unparalleled success to the program. He has won the Region VI Championship and two straight Jayhawks Conference titles. As well as breaking every school team and individual record here. He is the two-time Jayhawk Coach of the Year. He is undefeated in Region play in three seasons and has coached five All-Americans and a Player of the Year. He has moved eight players on to NCAA D1 colleges and many others to four year institutions. Prior to coming to Barton, Twelvetrees served as the Head Coach at Wayne State College, NCAA DII where he guided the team to conference play-offs every year. In his second season he produced an 11-9-3 record, the first winning season in four years and good enough to be named in the Top 15 Most Improved Teams in the Nation. In 2004 he graduated with his Masters Degrees in Sports Science from Bemidji State University, MN, while at Bemidji working as an assistant coach for women's soccer.

Bryan Sailer will be entering his 3rd season as the Women's Soccer Coach at Barton this fall. In 2008 Sailer brought the Women's team their first ever Jayhawk Conference Title and Sailer was named Coach of the Year. He also coached Barton's first ever All American Yesenia Garcia who was also Player of the Year. He also broke every team and individual record finishing with a record of 18-3, the best in School history. In 2007 the Cougars tied a school record with 10 wins finishing with just the 2nd winning record in school history at 10-8-2. Prior to Barton, Sailer was High School Coach of the Year three times at in Colorado at Fort Collins HS winning 5 consecutive conference championships the boys and girls teams. He graduated with a PE degree from New-York Brockport.
